Day 1Confronting Fear– Today, we pray that our trust in God will surpass that of any

Day 2Protection for Frontline Workers– This day we as a church pray for all FrontlineWorkers (doctors, nurses and other health care workers). We also call on the Lord to coverall our members and friends who are required to venture out into the society to work.(Psalm 91 & Isaiah 54:17)Sunday. January 2, 2022
